This election will be conducted in accordance with the **Special Regulations and Uniform Community Regulations of the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Toronto (Canada)**, under the Canonical Jurisdiction of the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople, Toronto 2001, including:

Article VIII, Section 2: A candidate for Community Council must be a **member in good standing** of that Community for at least two full years immediately preceding the date of the election, who lives his or her life and activities in accordance with the faith and canons of the Church, and shall not be a member of a Council of another Community.

Article VIII, Section 3: Candidates for election to the Community Council shall be nominated at the last Community Assembly preceding the election. Nominations may be made by a nominating committee or **by written nomination by two members of the Community in good standing** at least fifteen days prior to the election.
